

DENTAL CROWNS

A crown is a cover or a cap that is placed over a tooth that has been severely damaged or decayed.

Benefits:

- Appearance - can help boost confidence and improve your teeth's appearance.
- Financial - can save money in the long run on extractions or dental implants.
- Functionality - help maintain normal chewing function.

What to Expect:

Step 1: Come in for an exam.

Step 2: We remove the cavity and decay.

Step 3: Build the tooth up.

Step 4: Prepare the tooth for a crown.

Step 5: We will create the crown in-house.

Why Dental Crowns:

- To protect a weak tooth (for instance, from decay) from breaking or to hold together parts of a cracked tooth.
- To restore an already broken tooth or a tooth that has been severely worn down.
- To cover and support a tooth with a large filling when there isn't a lot of tooth left.
- To hold a dental bridge in place.
- To cover miss-shaped or severely discolored teeth.
- To cover a dental implant.
- To make a cosmetic modification.
