VENEERS

A veneer is a custom-made, thin piece of porcelain that is applied to a tooth to help recreate a healthy, natural look to your smile.

Veneer Facts:

- Can last up to 20 years with good oral health care.
- Least intrusive option compared to crowns and bridges.
- They are strong and resilient.
- Custom made to match your smile.
- They are irreversible.
- They will last a while with good oral hygiene.

What to Expect:

Step 1: Come in for an exam.

Step 2: We clean the tooth and determine what color you need.

Step 3: We will take an image or impression of the area.

Step 4: We will place a temporary veneer while we send your impression to a lab to create your veneer.

Step 5: When the permanent bridge is ready, the dentist fits, adjusts and cements the bridge to the prepared tooth and a light is cured for 60 seconds to secure the veneer.

- Veneers help close gaps in your smile.
- If you have a chipped tooth, veneers can replace the missing area.
- Veneers help correct misalignment.
- Veneers are a good option if you have stained teeth or discoloration.
- It can cause stress on other teeth and your jaw bone.
